Frontier has spent time working with:

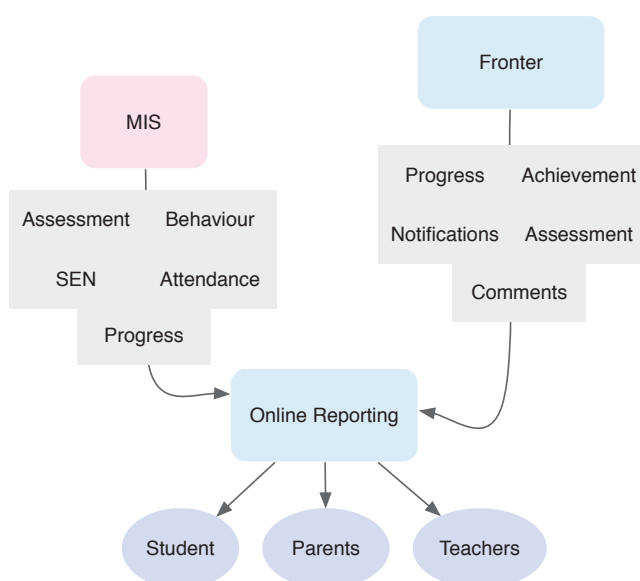
- Local Authorities and Schools to gather expectations around Online reporting requirements

Frontier is committed to providing a competitively priced solution that allows schools to meet the DCSF expectations for ‘Online reporting’.

To this end Frontier intends to provide a substantive solution before June 2010:

- Parents will be able to view useful reports regarding their children.
- Teachers will be able to take advantage of MIS data in the classroom and at home when designing lessons and / or courses.
- Students will be able to see data within the Learning Environment from the MIS as schools prescribe.





Online Reporting

The solution in two steps:

Data extraction

Frontier is developing a solution for extracting data from within the MIS, via a local installed application - all the major UK MIS systems used by maintained schools will be accommodated. Information extracted will generally include:

- Summative assessment
- Session attendance
- Behaviour
- Special Education Needs
- Progress data

Viewing reports in Frontier

It will be possible to display behaviour and attendance data:

- Generated from external applications i.e. different MIS applications.
- Generated from tools and functionality available within Frontier e.g. the Goal tool and Individual Learning Plan tool (to be released Autumn 2009).
